Schoharie Valley Community Camp July 17 – 21, 2017 Junior Counselors

Job Description: The Junior Counselors are essentially counselors in training. These are younger counselors who will assist with the counselors in leading and working with the kids in the Camp program.

Responsible To: The Junior Counselors are responsible to the counselor they are working with and ultimately the Head Counselor and Directors.

General Responsibilities: The general responsibilities of the Junior Counselors are to assist the volunteer counselors in working with the campers during the Camp program.

Specific Responsibilities:

- Arrive at Camp at 7:45 am and stay until 4:30pm (if you are with Pre-K Camp or Morning Camp, you will help with Day Camp afterwards as directed by the Head Counselor).
- To work with a group of campers as a help and support to them during the Camp program.
- To assist the volunteer counselors and the other staff in working with the campers and participating as part of the Camp program.
- To attend and participate in staff training and any training pertaining to the volunteer counselors.
- To be present during all of the days of the Camp Program.

Requirements:

- Junior Counselors must be at least 14 years old or entering the 10th grade.
- Must be energetic, enthusiastic, and enjoy working with children.
- Must be willing to help campers in participation with games, crafts, and other activities.
- To attend the mandatory training session on Sunday, July 16th from 4-8 PM at the Schoharie United Presbyterian Church. This will include a pot luck dinner. The training session will be for everyone involved in Day Camp, Morning Camp, or Pre-K Camp in any capacity.
