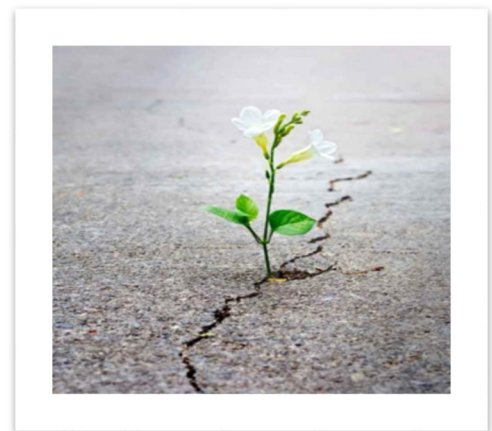

April 22 – Troubled Times

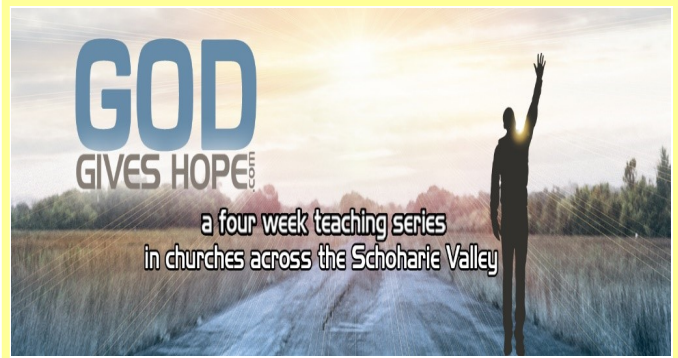
April 29 – The Future

Sanctuary

Lots of little things are happening:

Pews are reassembled. Contractor is doing minor shimming and reinforcement. When the weather warms, they will fill screw holes, do minor touch-up finish repair, and apply a final coat of polyurethane. Warmer temperatures are needed so the windows can be open for ventilation. Pew cushion vendor will be submitting a quote.

Fellowship Hall - Big sink spray wand installed; stove tucked in better; casters installed on "island"; closet door trimmed; and closures installed on exterior doors.



We hung a larger flat screen TV in the Hall. Then Vince Smith figured out how to transmit a live video feed of the worship service to that screen – so any folks downstairs can watch and listen to the service. This will be good for nursery for example.

The old flat screen was moved back to the Heritage House. We are looking for a donated good DVD/Blue-ray player to connect to that screen.

Balcony – The area for the small electric organ is being finished; ceiling holes being covered.

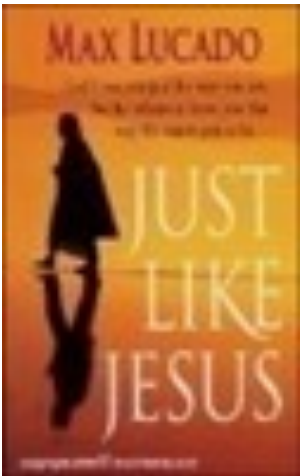

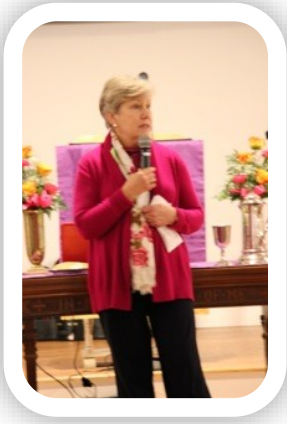
