Morning Camp Recreation Leader

Brief Job Description:

The primary purpose of the Recreation Leader is to work under the supervision of the Morning Camp Directors in order to plan, develop, and lead five days of half-hour rotations of fun, positive games for the campers. Each day, one half-hour rotation will be spent with Pre-K/K Campers and one half-hour rotation will be spent with 1st/2nd Grade Campers. The Morning Camp Recreation Leader also assists in All-Day Camp once responsibilities with Morning Camp are concluded.

Qualifications:

Applicants must have completed a minimum of a 10th grade level of education. Preference will be given to those with prior Schoharie Valley Community Camp counseling/junior counseling experience.

Specific Job Requirements of the Recreation Leader are:

- To attend all leadership meetings prior to the start of Camp.
- To assist with Day Camp after Morning Camp ends.
- To work with the Morning Camp Directors to plan age-appropriate, positive games to be played during Camp.
- To work with the staff to gather any necessary resources and materials needed for the recreation program.
- To be responsible for the primary set-up for the recreation program each day.
- To lead two half-hour rotations (one with Pre-K/K Campers and one with 1st/2nd Grade Campers) each day.
- To be responsible for the primary clean-up for the recreation program each day.
- To do any necessary planning and preparation for the next day's program.
- To display a positive, Christian attitude at all times, especially with the children, and other staff/volunteers.
- To attend the mandatory training session on Sunday, July 15th from 5-8 PM at the Schoharie United Presbyterian Church. This will include a pot luck dinner. The training session will be for everyone involved in Camp in any capacity.
