Consistory is still working on getting pulpit supply each Sunday. Jeff Kelly, Pastor of Middleburgh Reformed Church is supervising our consistory meetings.

Sarah and Cindy attended the classis meeting. There are thirteen churches in classis and only three have pastors.

Cindy and Luke continue to meet with the Presbyterian church. They are working on having a community Thanksgiving service the Sunday before Thanksgiving. There are other items both churches are working on to get the community involved.

We spent \$35,529.60 in expenses from June to September. During that timeframe we brought in \$25,622.72. We should see a shift and our reserves should start to build back up, but we need donations to continue in order to achieve that.

We want to thank Liza for leading the book review on David. Along with our church there are three people from the Presbyterian church attending.

We also want to thank Liza and Marion for doing a great job with Christian Ed. They are doing a lot of work opening our doors to our community's youths needs.

After School Program

The Schoharie Christian After School Program has gotten off to a wonderful beginning this year. We are at full capacity with 44 children. We do not have any more than 38 on any given day...but still a loud, fun, and curious group!

We have a large number of 4- and 5-year-olds this year, so our program started off the year teaching the basics about the Bible and God's love. The golden rule is taught daily as we do expect kindness and respect to be shown to all.

We are beginning our prayer chain this month which will continue all year. The chain will reach around the room by the end of the year. Each child will add a link to the chain at least once a week with a prayer on it for someone they know or even themselves. Prayer is a big part of lessons since many children do not understand the kinds of prayer and just how much a part of our lives it should be.

We are now working on Operation Christmas Child and plan to pack the shoe box size boxes for children in third world countries. Mary Lou Ryan from the Middleburg Reformed Church came to our program and shared a wonderful slide show of her visit to Africa while the boxes were being passed out and talked to the kids about the program. It was delightful. If anyone would like to donate items for the boxes to our program, we can get them a list of what is needed.
